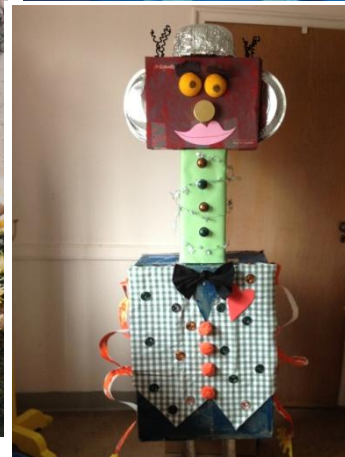
THECHURCH IN THE HIGHLANDS EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER ...
